impugn (verb) – to attack as false or questionable

mar (verb) – to damage, render less perfect or attractive; to disfigure or scar

pejorative (adj) – expressing disapproval or belittling the importance of something

vex (verb) – to bring trouble, distress or agitation to

vindictive (adj) – revengeful; spiteful
